

# National Girls Ministries Leadership Development Units: Bronze, Silver, and Gold

The *Leadership Development Units* have been developed to provide additional training resources to leaders. Due to the vital importance and relevance of this material, two training options are provided.

## Option 1 Achievement

Honor Sponsors and Honor Coordinators (in the 1998 curriculum) may obtain a higher level of achievement by becoming Honor Sponsor or Honor Coordinator Bronze, Silver, and Gold.

### Bronze Level of a Achievement Requirements

- Be an Honor Sponsor or an Honor Coordinator in the 1998 curriculum (see pages 52-54 in *Missionettes Leader Training Guide* for Honor Sponsor/Coordinator requirements)
- Complete the requirements for *the Leadership Development Units: Bronze Level* (see page 6 in the MLDU: Bronze Level for course requirements)

### Silver Level of Achievement Requirements

- Be a Bronze level of achievement recipient
- Complete the requirements for the *Leadership Development Units: Silver Level* (see page 6 in the MLDU: Silver Level for course requirements)

### Gold Level of Achievement Requirements

- Be a Silver level of achievement recipient
- Complete the requirements for the *Leadership Development Units: Gold Level* (see page 6 in the MLDU: Gold Level for course requirements)

**Completion of the course requirements qualify a leader to wear the Leadership Development Units: Bronze, Silver, and Gold Pins**

## Option 2 Personal Development

Leaders who have not completed the requirements to become Honor Sponsors or Honor Coordinators may complete this training simply as a personal development course to enhance their ministry skills. They, however, are not eligible to wear the MLDU Bronze, Silver, or Gold pins until they complete the achievement requirements.
